From birth to four years a child's assessment tends to be more informal. Although we try to include standardized tests where possible we rely mostly on collateral information and observations to determine whether our children's development is on par.

An assessment consists of four components:

1. Parent interview (108 for the first 30 minutes = R297.00, 109 for each additional 15 minutes = R148.40) of 60-90 minutes
2. Assessment (211 = R1,048.00)
3. Scoring and interpretation of test results as well as the compilation of the assessment report (110 = R230.50)
4. Feedback and recommendations (108 for the first 30 minutes = R297.00, 109 for each additional 15 minutes = R148.40, 401 = R209.80) of 90 minutes

If you do not have a medical aid or choose not to make use of your medical scheme your child's assessment has to be paid for on/before the day of your child's assessment. The amount is R3,000.00 (all inclusive).

Should you wish to make use of your medical aid your account will be submitted directly to your medical scheme.

There are no fixed medical aid tariffs and each medical aid has an individual payment agreement with service providers (you can however use the prescribed minimum tariffs for Occupational Therapy as a reference (*see above*)). Your medical aid will be charged according to this payment agreement.

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We do not charge more than what the medical aid is willing to pay and as a result you should not have any co-payment, provided that your scheme covers Occupational Therapy and that you have sufficient funds available.

When you book your child's assessment online, please note that the assessment takes place over two days.

On day one (Monday/Wednesday) your parent interview and your child's assessment/observation will take place.

When you arrive at the practice kindly park your vehicle on the paving on the sidewalk and proceed up the driveway to the office where we will commence your parent interview promptly at 08:00.

Your child should be dressed in comfortable clothes that will not restrict his/her movement.

There are several forms that needs to be completed prior to your child's assessment. You can download them in the **DOCUMENTS** section of my website and bring them along on the day of your child's assessment.

For you to fill in:

1. Patient Agreement (this form will be completed online when you schedule your appointment). Please note that you will have to upload the following documents – make sure that you have a copy of it available on your computer:
 - a. Your child's birth certificate
 - b. Identity document of the person responsible for payment of the account
 - c. Your medical aid card (should you wish to make use of your medical aid for payment)
2. Sensory Checklist
3. Milestone Checklist

For your child's teacher(s) to complete:

1. Sensory Checklist
2. Milestone Checklist

Please bring along the following additional documents on the day of your child's assessment:

- Your child's clinic card

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- Your child's school report cards
- The completed forms that you and your child's teacher completed
- Any medical/evaluation reports your child has
- Proof of payment if you are not making use of your medical aid.

I am going to ask you about:

- You/your wife's pregnancy with your child
- Your child's early developmental milestones
- Your child's diet
- Your child's daily routines
- Discipline in your home
- Your child's emotional adjustment
- Your child's social adjustment
- Extra-curricular activities
- Your child's academic history

Please note that your feedback session (this appointment is for parents only and your child will not be accompanying you) will take place on the second day (Tuesday/Thursday) at 08:00.
